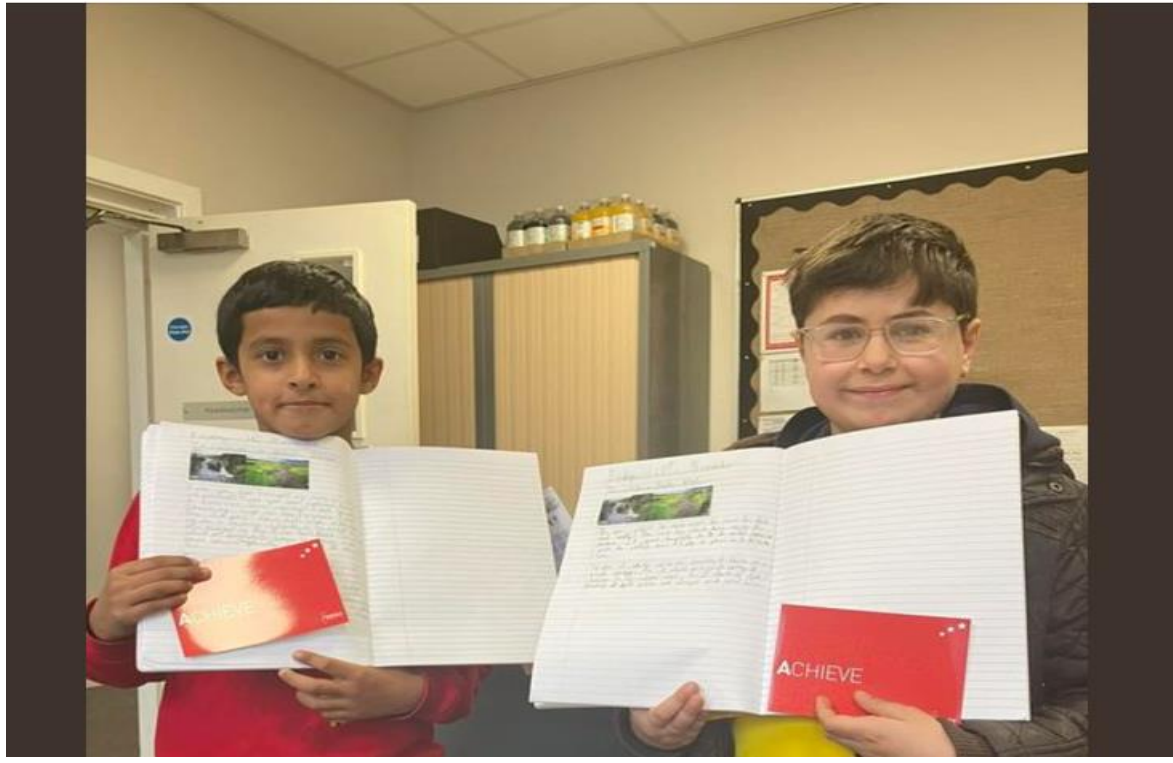

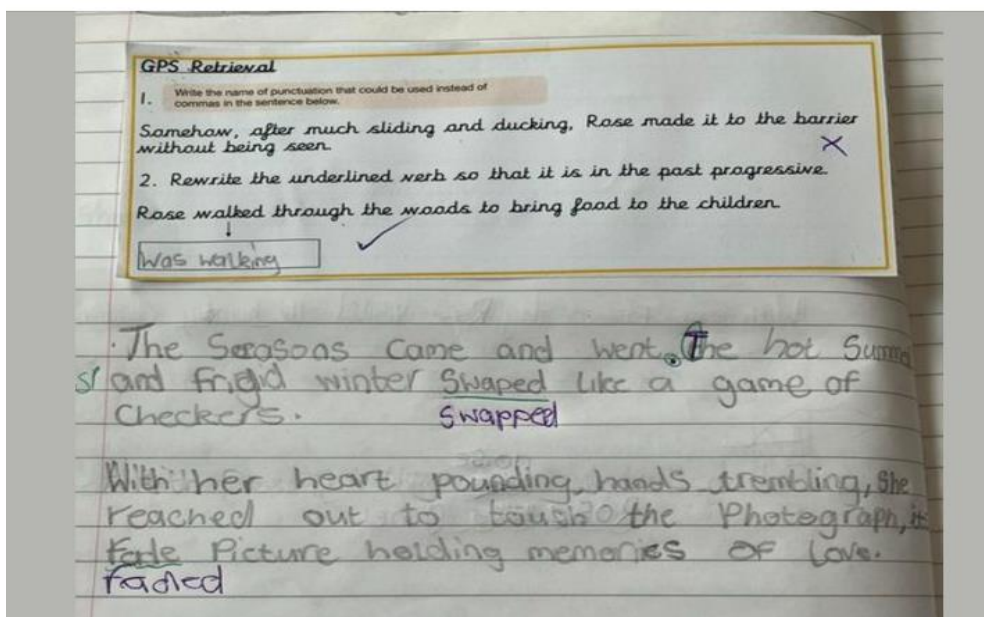


Achieve

Muhamed and Karam were rightly impressed with their progress in writing - as was Miss Dunn on Friday 🌟🌟🌟🌟

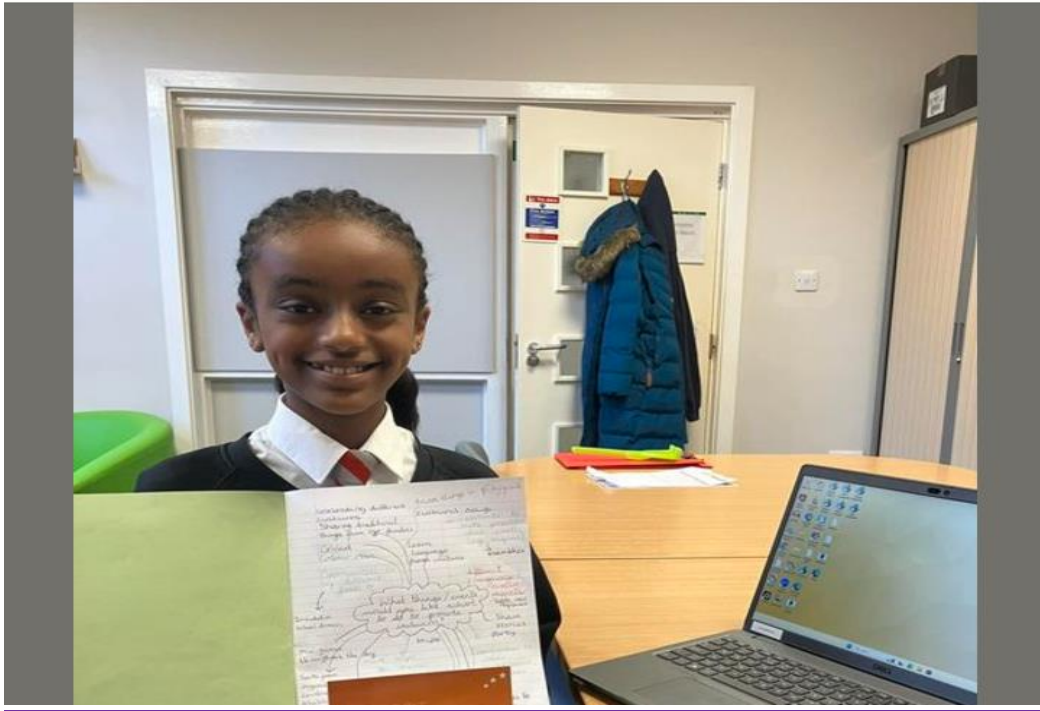
